

Split your contributions

Use this form to split your superannuation contributions with your spouse.

Please read this information before you complete the form

You can make one contribution splitting application up to 85% of your eligible contributions to the Fund for the previous financial year (no earlier). Your spouse does not need to be a member of Prime Super to receive your contributions.

Under government legislation, you can split the following:

- Superannuation Guarantee (SG) contributions
- salary sacrifice contributions
- personal contributions you intend to claim a tax deduction on.

Note: If you intend to claim a deduction for personal superannuation contributions made during the relevant financial year, you must provide your notice of intent to claim a deduction before you lodge this form.

Leaving the fund?

If you are leaving the fund, you can submit a contribution splitting application for the current financial year. You must provide this form before providing a Benefit payment form as we will not be able to process the contribution split afterwards.

Providing proof of your identity

When completing this form, you will need to provide proof of your identity. There are two ways to do this. You can take the paperless option and consent to an electronic identity verification, or you can provide certified, printed copies of identity documents.

Electronic identity verification

Using the electronic identity verification, you must provide details from your Medicare card, current Driver Licence and/or your passport. We use two of these documents to confirm your identity.

Certified identity documents

You will need to post a certified copy of one of the following documents:

- birth certificate
- passport
- certificate of Australian citizenship
- current Driver Licence

Certified copies are clear photocopies of original documents, which are signed by an authorised person and 'certified' as being true and correct copies of the original documents. You will need to show the authorised person the photocopied documents to be certified, along with the original documents for reference.

7 Provide proof of your identity

Superannuation funds are required by law to identify, monitor and mitigate the risk that the Fund is used for money laundering or financing terrorism. In order to comply with the law, we require all income stream applicants to provide proof of identity documents with their application. We cannot process your application if you do not provide these identification documents. You have two options: to provide electronic verification, or attach paper copies of certified documents.

Option 2 – I want to attach paper copies of certified documentation

All pages must be correctly certified as a true copy of the original document on each page.

The certification must include the certifier's signature, printed name, qualification (e.g. police officer), a contact number and the date. A certification must contain an original signature. Certification of personal documents

All copied pages of ORIGINAL proof of identification documents (including any linking documents) need to be certified as true copies by any individual approved to do so. The person who is authorised to certify documents must sight the original and the copy and make sure both documents are identical, then make sure all pages have been certified as true copies by writing or stamping 'certified true copy' followed by their signature, printed name, qualification (e.g. Justice of the Peace, Australia Post employee, Police Officer, Doctor, Pharmacist, Solicitor etc) and date. See Statutory Declarations Regulations 2023 for a full list of people who can certify your documents.
